## **CREATE Announces 2021 Community Arts Grant Awardees and Arts Celebration**

**Catskill, NY – April 1, 2021** – Greene County Council on the Arts, d.b.a. **CREATE C**ouncil on the Arts is pleased to announce the awardees of the 2021 Community Arts Grants! The Community Arts Grants Program funds artists and organizations who are seeking to creatively engage their communities through projects in the arts in Columbia, Greene, and Schoharie Counties. Grants of up to \$5,000 are awarded in three project areas: Community Projects, Artist Commissions, and Arts Education projects. In 2021, 50 grants totaling \$126,000 were awarded to artists and organizations.
